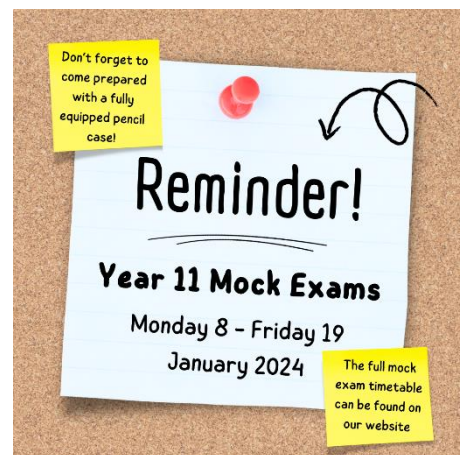
Welcome back to Term 3! We hope you all had a restful break with friends or family.


